## **Reminders & General News**

Off leash dogs are STILL a problem. Yes, your dog is friendly until it's not. What happens when they chase that squirrel into the road? Keep them leashed as per city of Kuna and Ada County code - even in your front yard! If you see an unleashed/ unattended animal - call animal control (number below)

Trailers, RVs, and boats should not be parked in the 2 street or your driveway. Prepping for a trip is fine for a day, leaving them out for days - not OK.

> Garbage cans - seriously - please put them in 3 your garage or behind your fence when it's not collection day.

Phase 5 houses are under construction! Phase 7 4 streets and utilities are going in and houses \*should\* start by November. Phase 7 will have a small park and pool. Fitz Roy Park is still in process with the city.

We are in the middle of the hottest days in the Treasure Valley, so it's important to remember a few tips for lawn care: 1. Don't mow your grass too short! Longer blades (2 1/2

- inches) keep water on the roots better.
- 2. Adjust your watering as needed. Watering twice a day or at night may allow better absorption than watering once during the heat of the day for a longer period.
- 3. Don't mow and water on the same day.
- 4. As the days cool down in September, remember to adjust the watering schedule.
