- 2.No alcohol at the pool. Seriously. Keep it in your own backyard or garage.
- 3.Make sure the pool gate closes behind you. We have had many non-residents sneaking into the pool behind residents. Every person/family group needs to "BEEP IN" with their fob.
- 4.No pets - the hair, the poo, the general mess.
- 5.Pool rule violations (food, drink, pets, disrespectful or aggressive behavior, unsupervised children, etc) may result in pool keys being disabled for the season.
