Kuna Community Food Drive

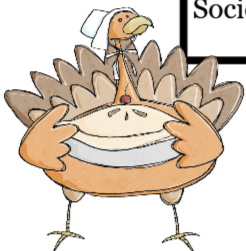

We have heard there have been a few packages stolen from front porches. Here are a few tips to help prevent porch pirates:

1. Have the package delivered to work.
2. Have package delivered to friend/relative/or neighbor that you know will be home.
3. Take advantage of "Ship To Store" that many stores offer. Amazon also offers a "locker" feature - check out Amazon.com for more details.
4. Request signature confirmation for delivery and have delivery alerts texted or emailed to you.
5. Ask carrier to place package out of plain view.
6. Have package held at post office for pickup.

Reminders & General News

1. Remember to "FALL BACK" this weekend!
2. The waterfalls and front landscaping berms are not a play area. Please keeps kids off these areas. Seems to be happening a lot in the morning while kids are waiting for the school bus.
3. Parking – do not block the sidewalks! Also remember that RVs, trailers, boats, etc. cannot be parked on the street or in your driveway - or across the street - you know who you are.....
4. Please keep your garbage and recycling cans behind your fence or in your garage on non-collection days.
5. Be sure to have your sprinklers blown out! You don't want broken pipes in the spring.
6. Homeowners are responsible for clearing snow off their sidewalks (too early???) Please do not throw the snow into the street!
7. ACC Forms are available if you want to put up a shed, pergola, etc in your backyard. In-ground flagpoles also need approval. Please email the office.
8. The new pathway in Fitz Roy Park (future Kuna city park in the NW corner of development) is approximately .37 miles - depending on how much your dogs wander as you walk them (with leashes, please!)
