Reminders & General News

1. The pool is closed for the season. See you in May!
2. Parking – do not block the sidewalks! Also remember that RVs, trailers, boats, etc. cannot be parked on the street or in your driveway.
3. Political signs – In March 2020, the State of Idaho passed HB 503 that modifies Idaho Code 55-115(5) It that states HOAs cannot prohibit political signs. HOAs can reasonably limit the timing, size, place, number and manner of display. If you are going to display political signs:
 - A. Timing: remove signs within 3 days after election/ ballot initiative/ or primary
 - B. Size and manner of display: Commercially manufactured signs roughly the size and shape of “For Sale” signs, no flags.
 - C. Number: one sign per yard
 - D. The only flags allowed are the American flag, state flags, branch of service flags, and the POW/MIA flag. No political, pirate, family crest, rainbow, or any other flags.
4. Thank you to the neighbors who alerted police to some suspicious activity in the new construction! Everyone from the builder, the home buyers, the developer, and the HOA really appreciate it!

The City of Kuna will be turning off the irrigation Monday, October 5th. Homeowners should arrange their own sprinkler blowouts. We recommend coordinating with your neighbors.
