- Off leash dogs are becoming a problem. Yes, your dog is friendly - until it's not. Keep them leashed as per city of Kuna and Ada County code. If you see an unleashed/unattended animal - call animal control (number below)
- Trailers, RVs, and boats should not be parked in the street or your driveway. Prepping for a trip is fine for a day, leaving them out for days - not OK.
