### PATAGONIA HOA POOL RULES

- 1. Hours of operation are from 7:00 am to 10:00 pm: Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend. The gate automatically locks at closing time.
- 2. No lifeguard will be on duty. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk.
- NO DIVING, RUNNING, PUSHING, OR SHOVING in or around the pool area.
- 4. All children 13 years of age and under MUST HAVE adult supervision at the pool at all times.
- 5. Guests are permitted when accompanied by a Patagonia homeowner; however, children under 13 must be invited and supervised by a parent. Maximum of 6 guests per family. There is no private scheduling of the pool.
- 6. Children in diapers are required to wear the special swim diaper. There are water borne illnesses that could shut down our pool if this is not strictly followed.
- 7. NO FOOD, DRINKS, GLASS CONTAINERS, ALCOHOL, OR TOBACCO in or around the pool area.
- 8. Always leave the pool area clean & be sure to take all of your belongings with you.
- No cut-offs or street clothes in the pool.
- No pets on premises or in the pool area.
- No abusive/foul language or rough housing.
- 12. No skate boards, roller blades, scooters, or bikes inside the pool enclosure.
- 13. Use of pool toys, balls, and floatation devices must be used with consideration for others using the pool. Inner tubes and oversized floatation devices are not permitted. Please take all floatation devices with you when you leave as remaining floats can block the filtration system.
- 14. Only one (1) pool keycard per household. Should you lose your keycard there is a \$25 replacement fee. Pool privileges will be revoked for HOA dues that are not current.
- 15. Any damage to the pool, equipment, or fixtures will be paid for by the responsible party.
- No music is allowed except with personal headphones.
- 17. Please shower off before entering the pool. The outdoor showers are located next to the restrooms.
- 18. Personal items are your responsibility; the HOA will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
